



This is a circular trail which starts off at the centre of Montaria. next to the Porta do Sítio da Serra d'Arga (Interpretation Centre). Head towards Montaria Parish Church – a Mannerist church with certain Baroque style features. There are several beautiful miniature nativity scenes to be admired inside the church. After passing the Montaria Calvary sculptures you will come to the famous "Costa and Lavadouro" water mills. These are still in use today and are shared by various families. The pathways and water channels that were built to use these mills, all confer a very picturesque setting to the local scenery. The trail continues on a shepherd's path – you will come to "Fojo do Lobo", a wolf pit. This is a typical construction with converging walls, once used to exterminate wolves. This ancient practice involved the entire village as well as nearby villages. Everyone took part in the hunt. Next, descend and return to the trail which will lead you back
