



collect rocks or catch animals.



Starting from the Santa Luzia Temple close to the funicular, we end up in the "Tílias" Park and crossing it until getting to the stairways that give access to the street and a picnic Park. From there we keep on going straight ahead, having on the left the Pre-Roman ruins of "Santa Luzia" and to the right, a mesmerizing view over the city and the river "Lima". Before passing by the reception building of the Pre-Roman Ruins, we turn to the right using a forest pathway then we follow until reaching the Military Firing Ground. A little further ahead, we get to the Leisure Park, which we cross towards the ancient forest house, where we can find a magnificent watchtower with an interesting view over the sea and the "Areosa" Valley. At this point we have to go back using the same pathway, turning then to the right after passing by all the military installation, to follow to the water tank, another interesting watchtower. It is relevant to note that this trail shares joint parts with the PR 9 - Trail of the "Canos de Água" (Waterpipes). We go down to the street, "keeping company" to the Pre-Roman Ruins until the crossroad leading to the Inn. We enter a forest area ending up in a ruined house located right next to the main street. At this point we keep on going towards the Temple, crossing the gardens which decorate the surrounding area. We finish the trail precisely at the Temple, enjoying one of the most beautiful landscape in the world.
